Version 2.0.0.22-23

- Added no-cache instructions to page headers.
- Fixed issue where Both Cremation and Transport did not populate correctly from new dropdown lists.

Version 2.0.0.21

- Changed fields with radio buttons to dropdown lists due to reported issue where those items did not show up when printing the application from within the web browser.

Version 2.0.0.20

- Added Disposition and Location fields when Out of Country is checked.
 - User must complete these when transporting beyond US borders.

Version 2.0.0.18

- Added "U" in Sex drop-down list for unknown stillborn.
- Retested date features and closing of all server connections.

Version 2.0.0.15

- Added feature to retrieve forgotten logins or to generate random password and send results via email.
- Included ability to generate/change password for all accounts with the same email.
- Enhanced error reporting to include user, if known.

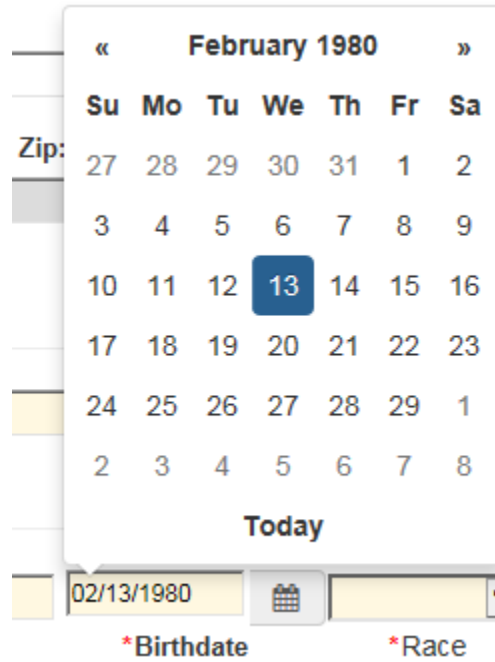
- Added calendar and time controls to facilitate entry of date and times.
 - Includes additional checks for valid date/time entries.

- DATE CALENDAR:

Click the calendar icon next to the field.

- Click the calendar header to quickly scan to new month or year.

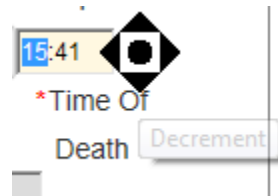
- OR you may simply type into the date field.



- TIME CONTROL:

Click up arrow to increment, down arrow to decrement, left and right to change fields as desired.

- OR you may also type into the time field.



- Improved City/County lookup feature.

- Stronger password requirements:
 - Must be 8 characters long with 1 upper case, 1 lower case, and 1 number.
- Improved session time out handling.
 - Inactive session timeout at 30 minutes.
 - A timeout warning is issued after 25 minutes without any post back to the server, such as selecting the City/County lookup feature, changing your password, or saving the form.



- If you do not click the banner, the session times out at 30 minutes and you will need to login again.
